PRICE OF GRAVES AT SACRED HEART CEMETERY

Infant gravesites are \$250.00 and are in a special part of the cemetery. These are smaller than regular gravesites. The placement of an Urn in a grave is \$250.00. These plots are also smaller than regular plots.

On July 1, 2010 the price of graves went up to \$1,200.00. This raise is necessary to offset the running of the Cemetery. Sacred Heart Cemetery is not a perpetual care cemetery so we must pay a groundskeeper to keep up the place. They work 5 days a week and on Saturday.

Did you know we have double lots available at Sacred Heart Cemetery? That is 2 persons can be buried in the same grave, one on top of another. They just bury the first person deeper than usual. The cost of the double plot is \$1,750.00. We have quite a few of these available in the new section of the cemetery.

Did you know Sacred Heart Cemetery has a Columbarium? Two urns can be placed in each niche and they are only \$1050.00. The Columbaria is in the new section of the cemetery and is beautifully landscaped around it.

It is important to note that the cemetery must record all burials even burials of cremated remains. You must go thru the office for burial of remains in a grave already occupied.
