A FEW QUOTES TO PONDER

I've been reading **"Things Hidden: Scripture as Spirituality"** by Fr. Richard Rohr, OFM. Here are a few words he wrote that might cause you to do some deep thinking about what He wants from us and what He wants us to do in His name:



"Jesus is not too interested in moral purity because he knows that any preoccupation with repressing the shadow does not lead us into personal transformation, empathy, compassion or patience, but invariably into one of two certain paths: denial or disguise, repression or hypocrisy. Isn't that rather evident? Immature religion creates a high degree of "cognitively rigid" people or very hateful and attacking people—and often both. It is almost our public image today, yet God's goal is exactly the opposite."

"Power, perks, prestige symbols and material possessions are the armor of the actor. These are the clear moral concerns of Jesus. Any over-concern for sexual rules or purity codes are almost always repression or punishment of shadow issues, and of other people, and Jesus shows little interest there."

"(Jesus) does not hate sinners at all, but only people who pretend they are not sinners!"
